- communicate the Company's health and safety policy, standards and procedures to all employees and contractors and verify they have the knowledge, skills and resources to comply with and implement this policy;
- maintain a positive culture of health and safety through consulting with all the stakeholders regarding their concerns, aspirations and values for health and safety related to our operations;
- establish and maintain our health and safety risk management systems based upon risk management principles appropriate to the nature of work undertaken;
- progressively develop and maintain clear, measurable health and safety objectives and targets aimed at the elimination of work-related injuries and illness;
- regularly audit our operational processes and procedures to continuously improve standards of performance; and
- actively respond to and investigate all incidents, with the aim of ensuring that all injured employees are returned to appropriate work through an equitable claims and rehabilitation process.

The responsibility and accountability for health and safety performance rests with every individual. Everyone shall, at all times, demonstrate their commitment to fulfil their 'Duty of Care' obligations in preventing all work-related injuries and illnesses.
